## FUNERALS AT SAINT JOHN'S

---

Saint John's is a serene and beautiful setting to honour the life of someone we love. It is available for funeral and memorial services, and maintains a beautiful garden for the interment of ashes after cremation. Services may vary from simple brief prayers for the deceased to a full choral requiem. The clergy of Saint John's are available to guide relatives through this time with help with funeral preparations.

## THE BARRY SHAW MEMORIAL GARDEN

---

The Barry Shaw Memorial Garden adjoins the Parish Church and is available for the interment of ashes for those associated with Saint John's. Interments are separate and permanent. The names of those who have died are inscribed in a Memorial Book located in the Church porch and prayers are offered for the deceased on the nearest Sunday to the anniversary of their death. Memorial flowers may also be arranged for the anniversary. A freestanding lych-gate offers a place of quiet repose for those who to sit quietly in the garden and remember those they love.

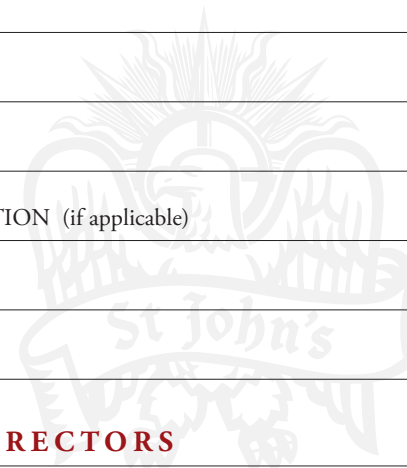
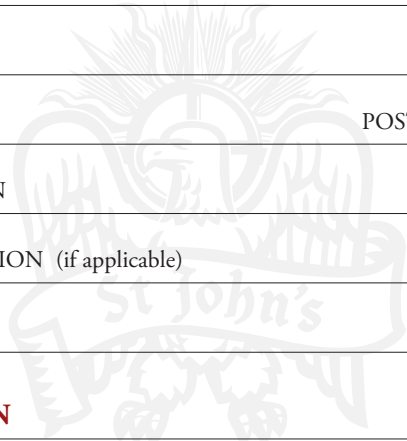

## SAINT JOHN'S COMMUNITY HALL

---

Saint John's Community Hall is situated directly behind the historic Parish Church and is a convenient venue that can be hired for functions after services. Built in 1906, the Hall is surrounded by charming gardens and an elegant rotunda and is equipped with a professional kitchen and a functioning theatre stage.

The basic venue hire cost is \$150 (incl. GST) for a self-catered function, including the use of the kitchen and basic crockery, cutlery and glasses. Information on local caterers to service your function can be obtained from the Parish Office. An additional fee applies for operation of the audio-visual system.

## FEES AND PAYMENT

---

The fee for a Funeral or Memorial Service at Saint John's is \$846. This includes fees for the Celebrant, flowers, the organist, document preparation, verges, and use of the building. Additional fees apply for operation of the audio-visual system and musical rehearsals if required. Payments for funeral services at Saint John's are most often arranged directly with the Funeral Director and a copy of the Invoice for our services are copied to the family.
